- He is near to you. Php 4:4-8
- He is our good shepherd who is feeding, leading, watching and saving us in the storms of life.
- He is always next to us.

What should we do?

- We should persevere in the storm.

- We should focus on Jesus.

What should we do?

- Keep on trusting.
- Worship God with thankful heart.

What should we do?

- Know that He is God.
- Reflect on the purpose.
- Pray for restoration.
