# Introduction


- **To fight with the devil, God has given us mighty weapons. It is the armor of God, which is for offense and defense.**

Therefore, we need to put them on daily.


# Belt of Truth

- Truth has three dimensions which are as follow: **Genuineness, veracity and faithfulness.**




# Genuineness

- The basic dimension of the divine integrity is God's genuineness. He is a real God. There is no falsehood in Him. Genuineness means –being true.
- The following bible passages teach us about God's genuineness. Jer. 10:5-10; John 17:3; 1 Thes.1:9; 1 John 5:20 and Revelation 3:7.




# Genuineness

- In order to fight with the enemy we have to become true. That happens when we believe in Jesus Christ. That is the positional truth. Jesus is full of grace and truth. Jn 1:14-17
- He is the way and the truth and the life. Jn 14:6




# Veracity

- **Veracity is the second dimension of truth. It means we represent things as they really are. Whether we speak of our self or others, we say as the things really are. In other words, we should speak truth.**
- **God does not and can not tell lie. 1 Sam 15:29; Titus 1:2 and Hebrews 6:18**




# Veracity

- God wants his people to speak the truth. Deut. 25:13-15 and 2 Cor 4:2
- In Psalm 15 David says that the person who speaks the truth from his heart, can have fellowship with God.
- Devil is liar. John 8:42-47




# Faithfulness

- **God's genuineness is a matter of being true, veracity is that he speaks truth and faithfulness is that he proves true. Numbers 23:19; 1 Thess. 5:24; 1 Cor 1:9 and 1 Peter 4:19**
- **He is covenant keeping God.**




# Faithfulness
