Introduction

God the father, Son and the Holy Spirit distribute Spiritual gifts to the believers at the time of their new birth; according to their sovereign, will for His glory and to build the Church. We have the responsibility to find out our gift/gifts and use it for the common good. **Definition of the Spiritual gifts.**

Ralph Neighbor in his book, This Gift is Mine, has this definition of Spiritual gifts. "Specific capacities produced in us by the entrance of the Holy Spirit. It means that I have received spiritual abilities as a member of Christ's body." **Definition of the Spiritual gifts.**

"A spiritual gift is a special God-given ability to serve the church in order to build it up to maturity in Jesus Christ." (BTCP, book 7, page 65). The root Greek word is "charis" = grace, "charismation"= grace-gifts.

- To prepare believers for the work of God. Eph. 4:12
- To create unity in the body. 1 Cor. 12
- To serve the body of Christ. Eph. 4:7-13
